Fertility Solutions

Fertility Solutions guides members through the fertility landscape to align the right treatment at the right time. We provide education and counseling through individualized case management, medical and pharmacy utilization management and a specialized, contracted Fertility Centers of Excellence (COE) network. This program improves treatment efficiency, maximizes pregnancy outcomes and helps reduce instances of multiple births.

Maternity Program

Identifying pregnancy risks early is critical to lessen the likelihood of a pre-term birth or birth complications resulting in a neonatal intensive care unit (NICU) stay. The Maternity Program identifies these risks early and supports women with high-risk conditions. We deliver an individualized case management care plan and connection to resources for each participant.

OB Homecare Services

OB Homecare Services provide members with high-risk pregnancies skilled nursing care at home upon physician referral. Program goals are to reduce maternal emergency room, antepartum hospital use, preterm births and NICU admission. Services include preterm birth prevention, including weekly medication administration, nursing and care management, nausea and vomiting management with continuous antiemetic therapy via micro-infusion pump with nursing and pharmacist support, diabetes in pregnancy and hypertensive disorders of pregnancy (preeclampsia) with device integration.

Neonatal Resource Services

Neonatal Resource Services improves outcomes of infants admitted to the NICU or other specialty care. We collaborate with providers and families in care planning, coordination of care and discharge planning. Our program offers support to families up to 30 days post-discharge and up to one year post-discharge for complex cases.
